

Report on Crockery Distribution



Tbilisi Lions Club has received another gift from the Basel Lions.

The Swiss Airline Cross Air once flew to Tbilisi does not exist any longer. The Air company sent for distribution free of charge all their material worth over one million EURO to welfare institutions around the world through Lions District 102 C, Organized by L Axel Scherrer.

Thanks to Basel Lions kind will the crockery had been sent to Georgia.

On December 20 "Willi Bets" trailer entered the Poti port bringing the gift from the Basel Lions. Since UNOMIG (Zugdidi- one of its location place) was the receiver, the cargo was transported from Poti to Zugdidi.

On December 21 the part of the cargo belonging to Tbilisi Lions was transported to Lanckhuti, (Guria region). ACTS Georgia provided the Lions with transportation. The cargo was stored in Lanckhuti Mayor's warehouse. Distribution of the cargo was carried out in Lanckhuti to orphanages and boarding schools and canteens in Imereti , Guria, Samegrelo, Zugdidi, Senaki , Adjara regions.
