

Report on School Inventory Distribution

In January 2006 Basel Lions conducted its humanitarian assistance to Tbilisi Lions and sent the school inventory and dressing material. It was the second time, which Basel Lions provided Georgian schools with inventory. The transportation was carried out by "Willi Bets"- shipping company. The cargo arrived to Tbilisi and was stored at ACTS Georgia's warehouse. Its distribution started according to the preliminary planning.

It is noteworthy that the population in Kvemo Kartli region is multinational. Georgians, Russians, Azerbaijan Greek and Armenians live there together. The children were happy to take their seats at new desks.



The boxes with dressing material were distributed to Tbilisi Psychiatric Hospital, Nabakevi (Abkhazia) village hospital, Batumi Children's Hospital and ACTS Georgia for distribution in Kvemo Kartli regional hospitals.
